They were very excited to see the great spelling strategies our students were using and to see the new evidence-based way our teachers teach language. We will have a few more teachers from their school next week to again watch the teaching and learning. It is so great to know that our schools great reputation is reaching other schools in our community. Next week we will have a curriculum day on Wednesday so that the teachers can further strengthen and develop their skills around he best teaching of writing. We are currently reading research around the teaching of great sentence construction and are implementing a program called 'The Writing Revolution' which will enable the students to write beautifully constructed sentences.

On the last week of term our school joined with 3 other small schools; Rawson PS, Narracan PS and Yinnar South Ps in a fantastic beach camp at Waratah Bay. The students made new friends and had some great experiences. Students pushed themselves and took on some risk taking by participating in activities such as a giant swing and a crate stack (while wearing a harness students climbed on a wobbly tower of foam blocks). We also enjoyed long walks on the beach while investigating all the sea creatures that had washed onto the sand and into the rock pools. It was great to see all the students smile lots, socialise with new kids and take some risks. We are all looking forward to our next camp.
